1. (Continued from Jan 11, 2000) update for a Request for a Determination of Applicability as filed by Polaroid for property located on John Verente Blvd, Map 133 and Lots 2,3 and 7. This project is to get a Polaroid Parcel Wetland Boundary Determination. There is no work proposed at this time. The representatives are Steven Damiano and Jeff Parks of TRC Environmental Corps. **Rescheduled per Steve Damiano due to the fact that flagging has not been started.**

2. (Continued from January 25, 2000) Notice of Intent filed by Filmore Summer Realty for property located at Cindy Lane, map 82 lot 173, 238 and 290-298. This proposal is to construct a 350 LF residential roadway. The representative is Rich Rheaume of Prime Engineering. There is also an Enforcement Order for SE49-216 map 82 lot 8 from April 30, 1998.

3. (Continued from December 28, 2000) Notice of Intent filed by Tim Kelley for property located at Roue 6/173 Pope's Island map 60 lot 12. The proposed work consists of repairing an existing docking facility including resetting damaged piles and repairing existing rip-rap seawall. All work will be done by floating barge and from upland. The representative is Rich Rheaume of Prime Engineering.
