1. Request for Determination of Applicability as filed by Rene Drouin, Jr. for property located at Durfee Street, map 75, lot 5. This proposal is to do grading, selective clearing and landscaping with 100 feet of a Bordering Vegetated Wetland. A siltfence will be installed along westerly property line and across the back of the lot and will act as a limit of work. Representative is also Rene Drouin, Jr. of Wetlands Consulting Service.

2. Request for Determination of Applicability as filed by TEC Associates for property located at the Conrail CSX-right of way. No work is proposed within wetland resource areas. Vegetation control will conform to the guidelines set forth in the Massachusetts Right-Of-way Management Regulations (333 CMR 11.00) and the preface to the Wetlands Protection Regulations (310 CMR 10.00) relative to the rights-of-way management. Representative is Wayne Duffet of TEC Associates.
