1. CANCELED UNTIL JUNE 13 MEETING

Notice of Intent as filed by Tim Kelley for 173 Pope's Island (con't from December 28, 1999 throughout this calendar year at their request). Applicant proposes to repair existing docking facility, resetting damaged piles and existing rip-rap. (Rich Rheaume of Prime Engineering to bring in new data along with clear and concise scope of work. New site plans are needed and a new filing with the state for a chapter 91 license.)

2. Notice of Intent as filed by Ray Barao for property located at 415 Wildwood Rd. map 103 F lot 7. Applicant proposes to replace a failed septic system and to construct a garage and gravel driveway within 100' of a bordering vegetated wetland. Representative is Rene H. Droiun, Jr. of Wetlands Consulting Service.

3. Request for Determination of Applicability as filed by New Bedford Aquarium Corporation for property located at 175 MacArthur Drive. Applicant proposes the excavation of test pits and soil borings/groundwater monitoring wells within the buffer zone of Coastal bank for due diligence activities at the site. Representative is Carl E. Tammi of ENSR.

4. Notice of Intent as filed by City of New Bedford for property located at East Rodney French Blvd. Applicant proposes to install 7,600' of sanitary sewer, a wastewater pumping station and 1,900' of force main. The roadway drainage system along East Rodney French Blvd. will be disconnected from the combined sewer system. Representative is Stephen Beyer of Camp Dresser & McKee.

5. Araujo Court (SE 49-196) Order of Conditions for roadway and detention pond (review revised drainage submission for compliance with original Order of Condition) and SE49-262 Notice of Intent for construction of 2 single family dwellings.
