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1. (Con't from July 25,2000) Notice of Intent as filed by A-1 Asphalt for property located at 1861 Shawmut Ave., map 124 lot 27. Applicant proposes a stormwater management design for the site and to restore and create wetland areas and restore the buffer zone. Representative is Rick Charon of Charon Associates.

2. Request for Determination of Applicability as filed by the City of New Bedford DPW for property located on Hawthorn Street. The City seeks to determine whether the boundaries of the resource area are accurately defined and whether the construction of a 6 foot wide paved path within the buffer zone of a Bordering Vegetated Wetland and/or Bank is subject to the jurisdiction of the Wetlands Protection Act.

3. Notice of Intent as filed by Oak Tree Carpentry for property located on Liberty Street, map 75 lot 542. The applicant proposes to remove fill material from Isolated Land Subject to Flooding and regrade the area to pre-existing conditions and seed to stabilize the area. Representative is Brian Leveque of SITEC Engineering.

4. Request for Determination of Applicability as filed by Jose Verissimo for property located on Fitzgerald Drive, map 130D lot 295. The purpose of this filing is to determine the wetlands delineation line. There is no work proposed at this time. Representative is Brian Leveque of SITEC Engineering.
